REPORT ON POLIO CAMP ON 31ST JANUARY, 2021



INTRODUCTION:

Pulse Polio is an immunization campaign established by the Govt. of India to eliminate Poliomyelitis (Polio) in India by vaccinating all children under the age of five years against the polio virus.

India is set to start its National Polio Immunization Programme on 31st January. It was earlier scheduled from 17th January but was rescheduled in view of the coronavirus vaccination drive that began on 16th January.

This year Polio camp held in adherence to COVID 19 protocol & guidelines. It is mandatory to maintain physical distance, to wear masks and wash hands during the activity.



OBJECTIVES:

- To immunize children through improved social mobilization, plan mop-up operations in areas where poliovirus has almost disappeared and maintain high level of morale among the public.
- All children under the 5 year should be vaccinated.
- To achieve certification of global polio eradication.



CAMPAIGNIMPLEMENTATION:

As per the part of Academic Curriculum, 14 students of 4th year B.Sc. Nursing, 11 students of 2nd year B.Sc. Nursing, 9 students of 2nd year M.Sc. Nursing & 2 students of 1st year M.Sc. Nursing from SSRCN along with 1 faculty actively participated in the Polio Camp on 31st January, 2021 from 08.00 am to 05.00 pm under the direction of Dr.Pandey, Urban Health Officer, Vapi.



A total of 18 polio booths were set up across the GIDC area, Vapi such as- Chintan Apartment, MIG, Kalikamata Mandir, Kamdar Office, Ghatkopar Sweet Mart, Shivmandir, Chetan Desai Clinic, Gurudvaru Chanod Colony, ESIC Hospital, Aata chakki (Ambamata Mandir), Chhota daya School, Dr.

Amisha Clinic, Surya Building, Rajmoti Apartment, Haria

ROTARY Hospital, Upasana School, Raj Residency

Apartment & Pramukh Hills and 5 polio booths

were set up across the Chhiri area, Vapi. Total 1225

children were vaccinated on that day.
