

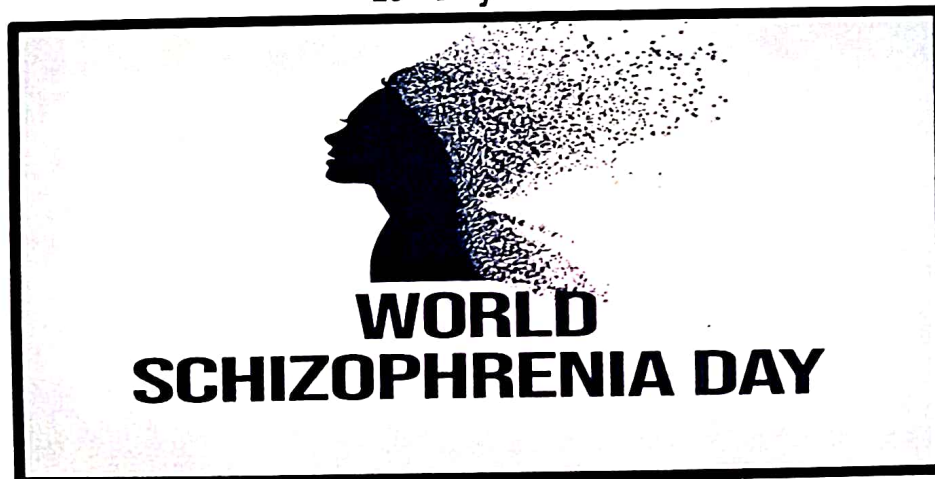

The theme of the World Schizophrenia Day 2025 was **"HEALTHY BEGINNINGS, HOPEFUL FUTURES"**


## **Incidence**


According to World Health Organization latest estimates in 2024, Schizophrenia affects approximately 24 million people worldwide, which equates to about 1 in 300 people worldwide. This rate is 1 in 222 people (0.45%) among adults. It is not as common as many other mental disorders. The prevalence of schizophrenia has remained relatively stable in recent years. Despite its relatively


low prevalence, schizophrenia imposes a significant burden on individuals & health care systems.

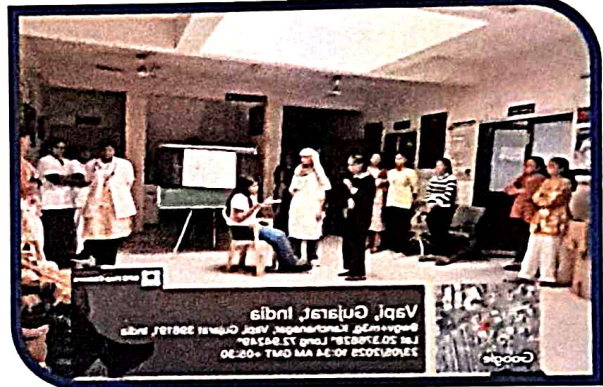
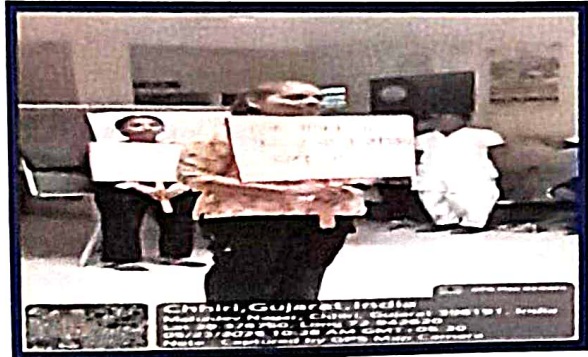
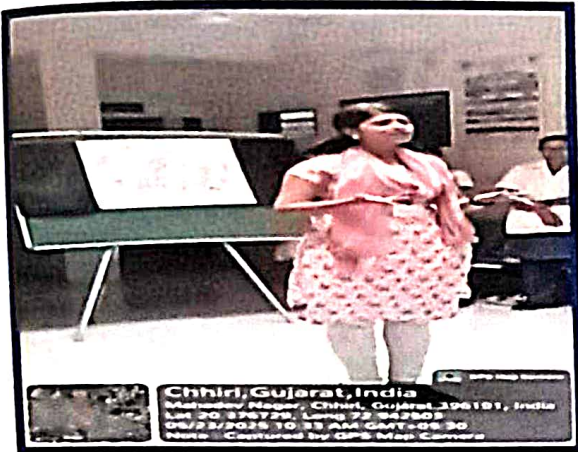
